Privacy Policy - Proposal

Introduction

This privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") applies to the processing or your personal data by SENSE Foundation Brussels. You will find below detailed information about how we collect, use, disclose, transfer and store your personal information and how to exercise your rights.

SENSE Foundation Brussels is committed to protecting and respecting the personal data that it collects and processes. In this context, SENSE Foundation Brussels complies with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC ("GDPR") and the Belgian Act of 30 July 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data.

Who are the data controllers of your personal data?

Your personal data is processed by SENSE Foundation Brussels ("The Foundation", "we" or "us") having its registered office at Avenue Herrmann-Debroux 48, 1160 Auderghem, Belgium, registered with the Crossroads Bank for Enterprises under number 0728940152.

SENSE Foundation Brussels is the "data controller" for the purposes of applicable data protection laws.

What is personal data?

"Personal data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ('data subject'); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

What data do we collect?

By accessing and surfing on our website (www.sensefoundationbrussels.org) or by interacting with us by any other means (email, phone or otherwise), you are informed that we collect and treat your following personal data:

- your IP address which is automatically detected by the server for each of your visits to the website;
- your name, organisation, phones numbers, private/professional email address, job title, name of business, business address, , if you submit a contact form and / or a call

for project form on our Website and / or if you have freely transmitted us this information by any other means (email, phone, etc.);

- any other information that you have voluntarily transmitted to us;
- information concerning web pages visited on the Website.

Why do we process personal data?

The purpose for which we use your personal data and the legal basis under data protection laws on which we rely to do this are as follows:

- If you have given us your **consent** to use it by submitting a contact form to receive communications and/or to interact with you;
- If it is necessary for the **performance of any agreement** you have concluded/ you intend to conclude with us, including but not limited to, financial support agreement;
- If it is necessary for **compliance with a legal obligation**. This includes when you exercise your legal rights under data protection law, to verify your identity;
- If it is necessary for our legitimate interest such as the improvement of our Website.

How long do we retain your personal data?

We retain your personal data as long as necessary to fulfil the purpose(s) for which we collected it and as long as we need it to meet our legal obligations. We may keep data for longer to establish, exercise, or defend our legal rights and the legal rights of our clients.

Who may access your personal data?

We want to be clear to we do not sell your personal data.

We may share your personal data with:

- Any third-party that process/store your data on our behalf such as entities providing services within the framework of The Foundation's support. All the service providers we work with are under contract with us and respect the GDPR. We only provide them with the data they need to perform the service they perform for us;
- Any other party if we are legally obliged to do so by law.

Locations of processing

Where possible, personal data resides within the EU territory but may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the EU. It may also be processed by staffs operating outside the EU who work for one of our suppliers. We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data is treated securely, in accordance with this privacy statement.

We have taken steps to ensure all personal data is provided with adequate protection and that all transfers of personal data outside the EU are done lawfully. Where we transfer personal data outside of the EU to a country not determined by the European Commission as providing an adequate level of protection for personal data, the transfers will be under an agreement which covers the EU requirements for the transfer of personal data outside the EU.

Your rights

You have the following rights in respect of the processing of your personal data:

- To request access to your information (i.e. to receive a copy of same);
- To have your information <u>corrected</u>, if it is inaccurate or not up to date (please note that
 personal data transmitted to us via the booking platform on our website may be directly
 corrected by you via the same platform);
- To have your information <u>erased</u>, although such right may be limited in view of our legal obligations;
- To receive free of charge a <u>copy</u> of your information in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and to transmit it to another data controller (i.e. <u>the right to data portability</u>);
- To <u>object</u> to processing of your information and to <u>restrict</u> processing of your information, although such right may be limited in view of our legal obligations;
- To <u>withdraw your consent</u> at any time, for any of the purposes for which we collected your personal data.

The Foundation's Team will also be informed and measures will be taken to ensure that future occurrences are prevented.

Our website uses cookies, as almost all websites do, to help us to provide you with the best experience we can. Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you browse websites.

We do not use cookies to:

- Pass data to advertising networks;
- · Pass personally identifiable data to third parties;

Third party functions

Granting us permission to use cookies

Should you wish to remove or not use cookies from our website you can adjust your browser settings, however doing so will likely mean that our site will not work as you would expect.
